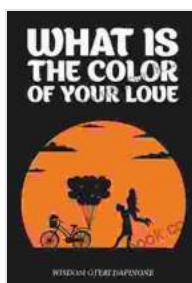
American Sonnets for My Father

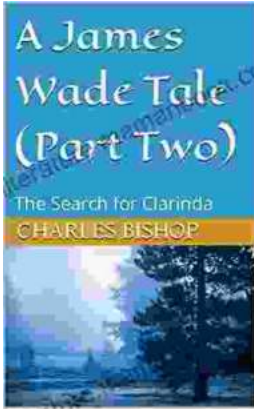

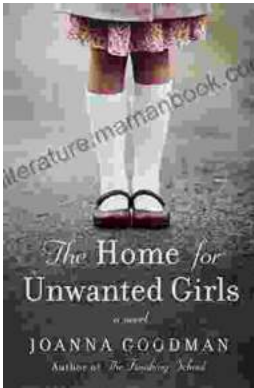
