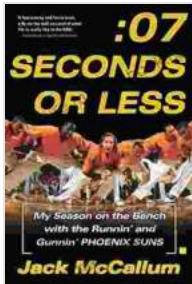

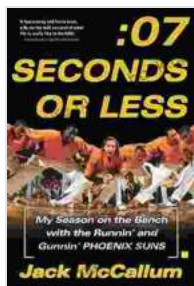
Looking back

- Playing against the Chicago Bulls in the NBA Finals

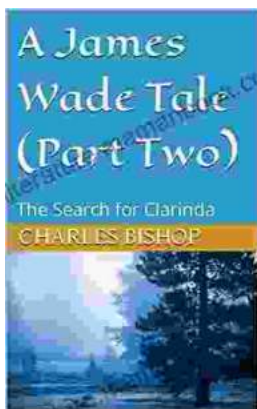
