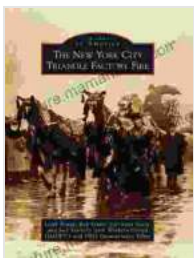


The New York City Triangle Factory Fire: Images of America

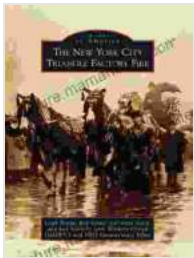

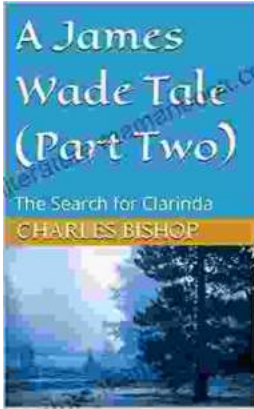

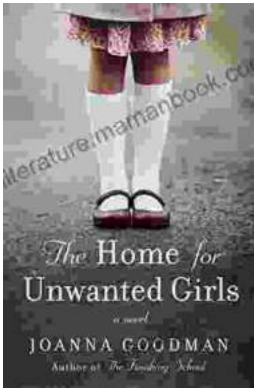
